This champagne offers a range of aromas including quince, brioche, peach, white flower, and a touch of raspberry dancing on layers of chalky minerality. It is elegant, refined, and structured. Fresh sensations with feelings of pears, apples, and white fruit. Nice finish. Beautiful yellow colour with bright flashes greenish foam and a crown.

MILLÉSIME 2020
Pretty pale-pink, very limpid colour with bluish reflections. This wine offers a very elegant nose with delicate notes of grapefruit and white flowers. Fresh and well-balanced, the palate is lively and reveals seductive aromas of citrus and sea iodine.

AF Gros Moulin-à-Vent 2018

Tasting Notes:

AF Gros is one of several elite Côtes-de-Nuits growers who are helping to create a groundswell of love around Beaujolais! Gemey is a grape with a gentle tannin, bright acidity and red berry floral bouquet - and this version is treated with all due respect: no carbonic maceration; instead made like traditional red burgundy and aged in large oak founders for one year. Moulin-à-Vent is the Beaujolais Cru that is the most Pinot of all - it's an exceptional terroir with great personality: elegant fruit, finesse, structure, and depth.

Domaine De La Janasse Côtes-du-Rhône Rouge Tradition 2019

Tasting Notes:

Moderately tannic and endowed with a beautiful structure, this Côtes-du-Rhône develops greedy notes of fresh fruit (crushed strawberry, blackberry) on their crunchiness, supported by a hint of liquorice.

Château Haut-Simard Saint-Émilion Grand Cru 2015

Tasting Notes:

The 2015 Château Haut-Simard is a blend of 40% Cabernet Franc and 60% Merlot, from one of the region's great families, the Vauthiers (also of Château Ausone). This is beautifully perfumed, with fresh violets, plum fruit, and lick of spice on the nose. The palate is sumptuous but not overpowering, with lovely savoury tannins, and a long, mouthwatering finish. This is a brilliant right-bank Bordeaux, from a great vintage for the region.
